This Evening's Performers

Matthew Rhodes, Tenor...

...performed his first solo recital in 2007 at St George's, Hanover Square, where he sang Schubert and Schumann lieder and Handel and Mozart arias, accompanied by Christopher Glynn. He has also performed at the Royal Academy of Music, at the Great Hall of Westminster School with mezzo-soprano Elizabeth Jenkin, and sang the tenor solo in *Messiah* at St John's Wood Church at the invitation of Mike Cayton. He most recently sang the two tenor solo parts of Armed Man and Priest in a production of *The Magic Flute* at Glyndebourne Opera House.

Charles Andrews, Organist...

...is Organist of St John's, Hyde Park and holds the Douglas & Kyra Downie Award at the Royal College of Music where he studies piano with John Blakely and organ with David Graham and Sophie-Véronique Cauchefer-Choplin. Until July 2007 he was Organ Scholar at Rochester Cathedral where he was the soloist on a BBC Radio 3 broadcast and was recorded by Herald for a 'Christmas Album'. Charles Andrews and Roger Sayer have given concerts in the U.K., Russia and the U.S.A. as the Midas Touch Organ Duo. In December 2007 they were guests on BBC Radio 3's 'In Tune'. A CD of organ duo music for Priory was featured on BBC Radio 2 programme, 'The Organist Entertains'. In 2010 Charles and Roger will perform a new piece composed for them by David Briggs. In 2009 Charles gave concerts at St Paul's Cathedral, Ripon Cathedral, and the church of St Michael, Cornhill. In March and October 2009 he participated in masterclasses at the St Alban's International Organ Festival. Plans for 2010 include recitals at St Stephen's, Walbrook, St Giles in the Fields, Brentwood Cathedral, Winchester Cathedral and Westminster Cathedral.

Charles is Accompanist of Eltham Choral Society. Charles has been generously supported by the Michael James, Trident and Henry Wood Trusts.

...began his musical career at the age of 16 as a trumpeter in the Grenadier Guards. He went on to study the piano at the Royal College of Music where he was awarded several prizes for conducting, composing and improvisation. He won a scholarship enabling him to continue his studies at the RCM as Repetiteur for the London Schools Opera whilst also becoming the first recipient of the Millennium Organ Scholarship at the Royal Hospital in Chelsea.

Michael is in demand as a choral conductor, accompanist and organist. He has performed at the Wigmore Hall, Royal Festival Hall, Albert Hall and in cathedrals all over the country. In the course of his career he has toured extensively to the United States of America, the Far East and Europe. Michael gave his debut recital as an organ recitalist in Westminster Abbey and has given recitals in many cathedrals and parish churches in the UK. He has made several broadcasts for BBC radio including a live broadcast for BBC World Service and has recently appeared on "Songs of Praise". Michael is Director of Music at St. John's Wood Church in London where he conducts the Church's critically acclaimed professional choir. He is also Organist at Belsize Square Synagogue and this is his 7th season as Musical Director of the Chiltern Choir. Michael's choral compositions are published by Redemptorist Publications.


